Project models are flexible: however, many schools choose to engage with us via one (or ultimately more) of these three routes:

One-day projects:

- 45min to 1 hour long sessions for 3 or 4 classes
- Delivered by highly trained musicians
- Fun, creative music-making for everyone to get involved in
- Bespoke sessions, tailored to the needs of your students and staff
- Optional staff training
- Advice and guidance on continuing music-making, instruments, and resources

Five-day projects:

- 45min to 1 hour long sessions for 3 or 4 classes – each visited 5 times
- Delivered by highly trained musicians
- Fun, creative music-making for everyone to get involved in
- Bespoke sessions, tailored to the needs of your students and staff
- Two staff twilight training opportunities
- Advice and guidance on continuing music-making, instruments, and resources

Extended Staff Development Projects:

- A year of training and mentoring for 4 key members of staff in creative music-making
- Whole school training in whole class and individual musical provision
- Bespoke sessions, tailored to the needs of your students and staff
- Support with instrument purchase and resources
- Delivered by highly trained and experienced musicians
- Ongoing advice, guidance and support

We also offer a free online resource library for schools and families:

- Library of training videos on our YouTube channel
- Song sheets, tips and advice in our website resources area
