



Recommended iPad apps

ThumbJam (£8.99)

You get over 40 high-quality instruments multi-sampled in this app. The app has a menu on the top left of the screen where you can change instrument sound, scale, and volume.

Bloom (£3.99 for iPad) or **Bloom: 10 Worlds** (£7.99 for android/Windows)

Simply tapping or dragging a finger on the screen produces gentle visuals and calming music that regenerates over time. Click on the icon in the bottom right corner to get to the settings page and play around. Very soothing.

AUMI (free)

AUMI enables the user to play sounds and musical phrases through movement and gestures, using the iPad camera to pick up movement and create sound. 12

Echo String Lite (free)

A lovely harp sound, with different chord options and a colourful interface. You can record as you play.

GarageBand (free)

A deceptively powerful app in which you can play a range of instruments - keyboards, guitars, strings, drums. You can record tunes and external sounds, and create loops.

Launchpad: Make and Remix (free)

Be an instant DJ. Combine beats, basslines, melodies, vocals and loops. Layer DJ-style effects to chop and change your sound. Very easy to use.
